


## What is the Common Application?

ALL public baccalaureates in Washington State are now using Common Application!!!










- Strong level of academic achievement
- GPA
- Rigor of curriculum
- Essays/Personal Statement
- Taken notable advantage of college preparatory courses
- Test Scores (rare)
- Quality Senior Year
- Positive grade trends
- Meet academic requirements CADR complete
- Extracurricular activities
- Letters of Recommendation
- Other factors/Personal characteristics

Each college is different and can set admissions criteria in accordance with their own mission.

## **Subject line**

✓ 2-5 word summary of the email

## **Start with greeting**

✓ Good Morning/Afternoon, Hello

### Provide details, be concise

✓ Don't assume the recipient knows what you're talking about

### Closing

√ Thank you for your help/have a good day/Sincerely
