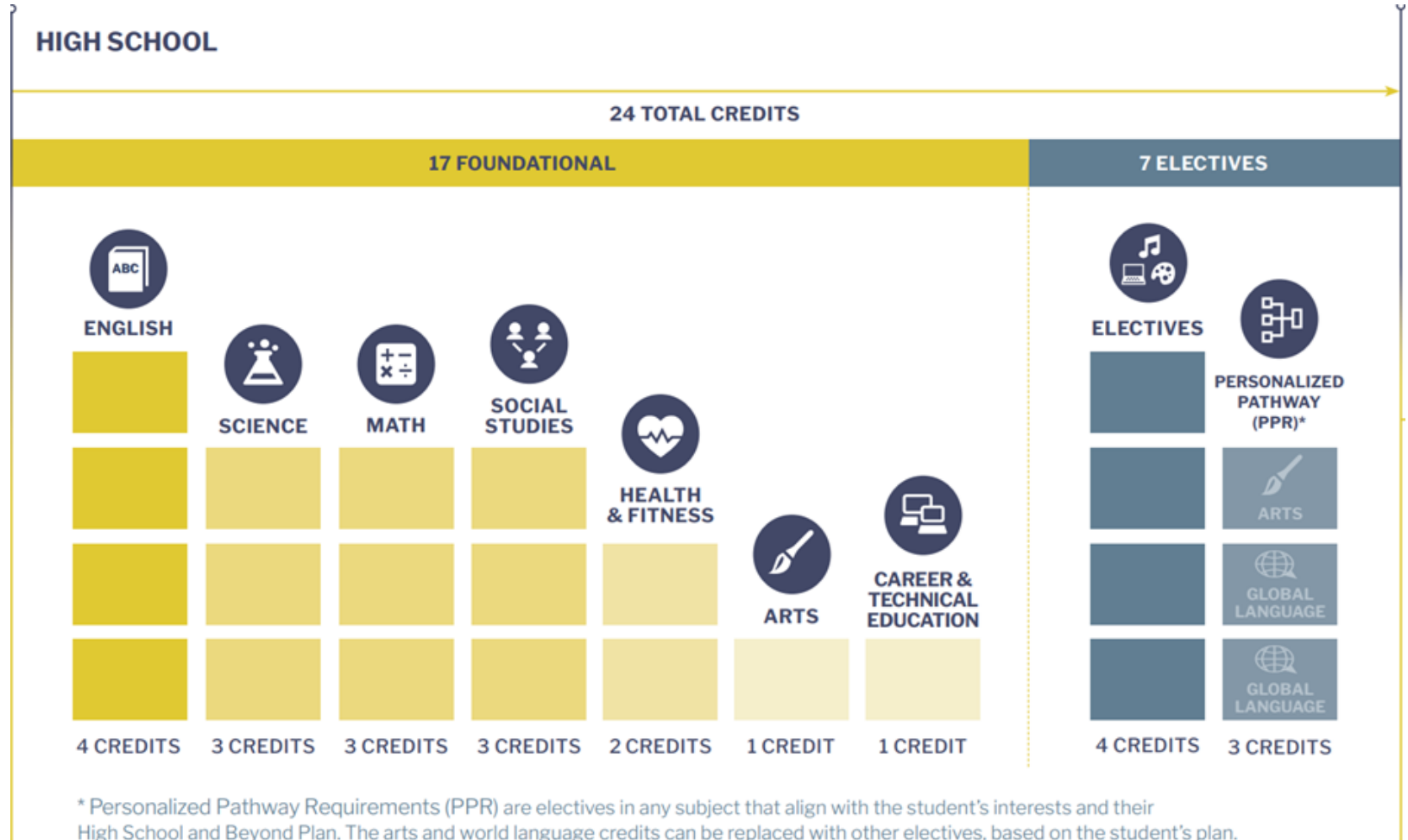
# 2027 GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

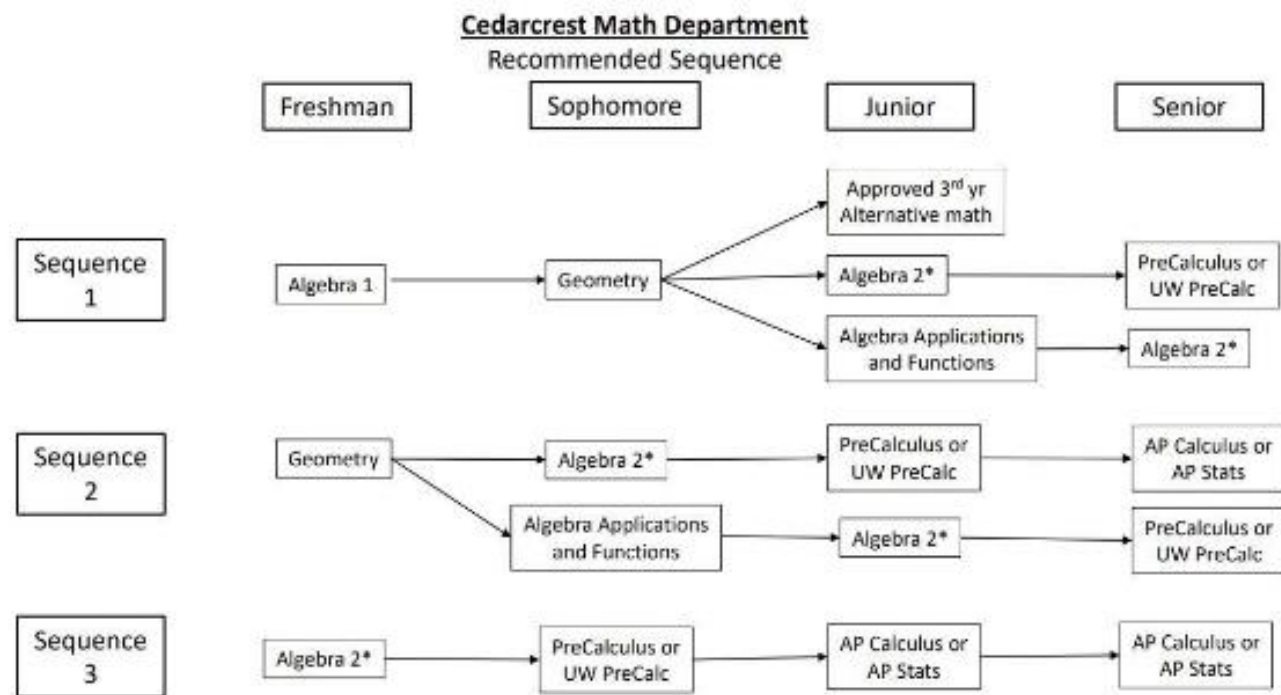


# Considerations for Course Selection

- Students taking Algebra 1, Geometry or Spanish 1 in middle school: Your credits will now automatically transfer up to your high school transcript!!!
  - You can opt out of having course grades and credits on your high school transcript or have grades be changed to a “P” grades.
  - Students have until the end of 11<sup>th</sup> grade to opt out by completing the Opt-out form signed by both parent and student.
- Applications for honors courses are NOT required.
  - Students will self-select into Honors. Students should review the recommended pre-requisites when making their selection.
  - See the 2022-23 Course Guide for course pre-requisites
- Please consider areas of interest, academic strengths and post-high school planning when considering rigorous course selection.

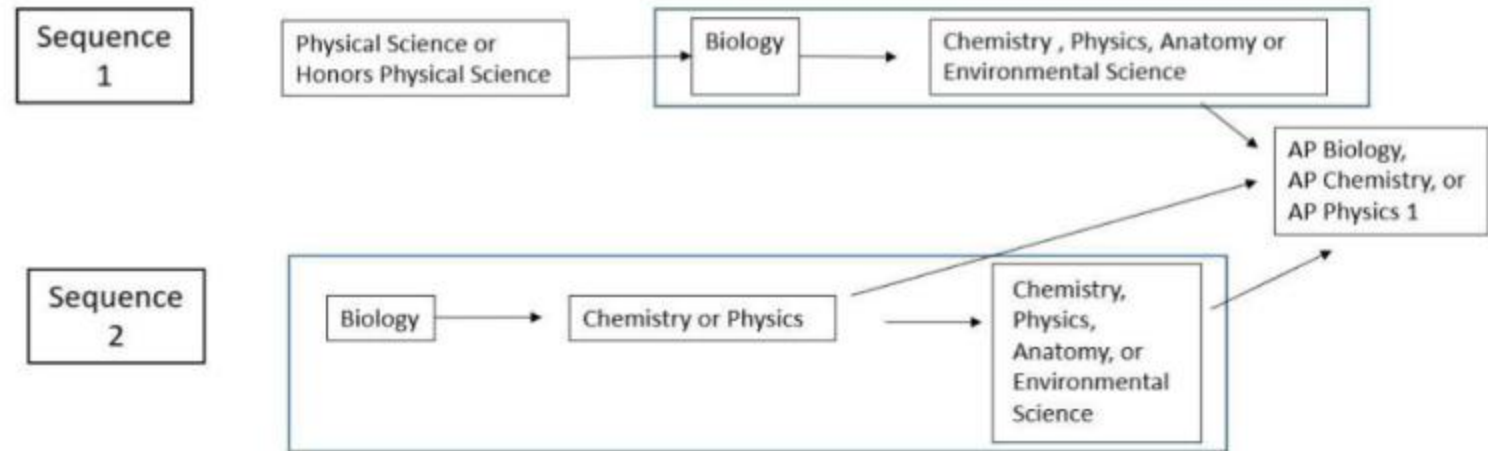


# Math Pathway



\* Algebra 2 meets the state graduation requirement and 4-year college entrance requirement.

# Science Pathway



- Students may move up or down into a different sequence.
- Students can enroll in two science classes in one year.
- Students must take a Chemistry course before taking AP Chemistry.
- Freshman starting in Biology should take Chemistry and Physics to meet recommended NGSS standards
- All Chemistry, Physics, and AP Physics classes are algebra-based.
- WA colleges require students have a senior math class, or algebra-based science class their Senior year. Students who completed Pre-Calc. are exempt from this recommendation.
